#### **ATTENDANCE**

We have had an excellent rate of attendance here at St Francis School this week. We have had multiple classes, on different days who have had all students at school. Well done everyone, particularly 4B & 5O who have had 4 days this week with every child at school.



The improvement in attendance this week has been remarkable. This week we have noticed a positive change in attendance with children making the decision to come to school and be a happy learner. We are striving for every student every day and on Wednesday there were only 10 children away across the whole school. You should be very proud of this effort.

## **Key Facts About School Attendance**

- Attendance affects academic achievement. Every day of attendance contributes towards a child's learning and enhances academic achievement.
- Attendance has a strong relationship with student outcomes as measured by NAPLAN scores. Each
  percentage point increase in attendance is related to higher student outcomes by an average of 2-3
  NAPLAN scale score points in numeracy, reading, spelling, writing and grammar and punctuation.
- Absence from school is associated with academic achievement in the current year as well as future years.
- If children do not attend school regularly they miss out on the chance to build a good attendance habit.
- Being absent for one day of school each fortnight (2 days a month) adds up to missing more than a year
  of learning over 10 years. This is called school absenteeism.
- Sporadic absences affect academic achievement as much as consecutive days.
- School attendance patterns are established early in Kindergarten and Year 1.

## **ROAD SAFETY AROUND OUR SCHOOL**

Please remember to take care and obey the road rules around our school. We have had some very near misses where parents and children have been almost hit by cars outside of our school while using the crossing on Stone Street.

Also a reminder to parents that if you are collecting your child from Gregory Street, you need to park your car and walk into the school. If you don't want to leave your car, you need to change the arrangements for your child to car pick up so your child can enter the car safely and not in the middle of the road as some parents are

allowing their children to do. We understand that after school, families have places to be but safety should always come first.

# SCHOOL ZONE OFFENCES WHAT ARE YOU RISKING?\*



Children are small, harder to see, behave unpredictably and are extremely vulnerable. They need YOU to take extra care when driving and parking around school zones.



## No Parking

You have 2 minutes to drop-off or pick-up. You must stay within

ENALTIES \$180 + 2 DEMERIT POINTS

3 metres of your vehicle. No waiting.



## No Stopping

You are not allowed to stop on a length of road with a No Stopping sign.

PENALTIES FROM \$325

2 DEMERIT **POINTS** 



## **Bus Zone**

You must not stop your vehicle in a Bus Zone unless you are driving a public bus.

Colas Solutions is to undertake asphalt pavement rejuvenation works for your local Council in various locations.

# THE PRODUCT AND APPLICATION PROCESS



The product is a water based bitumen rejuvenation agent and is applied to the surface of the pavement by a pressure spray system. The product dries within about 2 to 4 hours of application, and can be trafficked immediately after drying. Our process aims to extend the life of the asphalt pavement before major rehabilitation reconstruction of the roadway is necessary. thereby reducing council's maintenance costs and ultimately saving money for the ratepayers.

Our product and application process is environmentally friendly, and contains NO solvents or harmful chemicals, which may damage our environment or more importantly our health. The product dries to a rich dark black color leaving an aesthetically pleasing finish.

## TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS



During the works we will have local traffic diversions in place to assist you to negotiate around our work sites However, we will need to close sections of your street to all traffic for up to Five hours to enable us to apply our product and for the product to dry. We will have our traffic controllers Door knock your property 15 mins prior to spraying. Immediately following drying, the roadway will be reopened for normal traffic use.

We request that you please obey our directions, which will ultimately speed up the works process and re-open the road for normal use sooner.

## WHAT CAN YOU DO TO HELP US!

We request that you ensure that all vehicles are parked OFF the roadway and that if vehicles are parked on your driveway or on the nature strip, that these vehicles are positioned at least 2 meters from the edge of the gutter. We would also request that sprinklers be positioned so that they do not spray the roads surface. Your help will ensure that we can carry on with the works without any untimely delays.

## TIMING OF THE WORKS

Working times will generally be between 7:00am to 5:00pm, however these times may change dependant on the of section of roadway being worked on
