


ST FRANCIS OF ASSISI UPDATE

SOCIAL SKILL - BEING POLITE AND COURTEOUS AT ST FRANCIS

ILLEGAL U-TURNS

Outside our school there are double white centre lines on both Armitage Drive and Stone Street. These lines mean that it is illegal to make a U turn in these areas. A U turn includes:

- making a three point turn
- turning into a driveway to turn around or
- changing from one direction to another in one or more moves.

U turns are very dangerous especially where there are children moving around. There have been cases of children that have been killed or seriously injured by a vehicle making an illegal U turn. We don't want this to happen at our school. Please be aware that council rangers and the police have been asked to monitor the school to help keep our children safe. The penalty for an illegal U turn in a School Zone is now \$330 + 3 demerit points.

Also illegal on or near a pedestrian crossing.

Children are small, harder to see, behave unpredictably and are extremely vulnerable. They need YOU to take extra care when driving and parking around school zones.



No Parking

You have 2 minutes to drop-off or pick-up. You must stay within

\$1**80** + 2 DEMERIT **POINTS**

PENALTIES FROM

3 metres of your vehicle. No waiting.



No Stopping

You are not allowed to stop on a length of road with a No Stopping sign.

PENALTIES FROM \$325 2 DEMERIT POINTS



Bus Zone

You must not stop your vehicle in a Bus Zone unless you are driving a public bus.
