Dear Parents

This Sunday our church celebrates the feast of the Ascension. This is when Jesus said goodbye to the apostles and went to join his Father in heaven. The apostles must have felt upset, knowing that Jesus would no longer be amongst them. They would have felt anxious and grief-stricken that they were losing their good friend. Jesus knew how they were feeling and comforted them with the words...

"I am with you always, yes until the end of time"

In a special way, Jesus is with us whenever we gather to celebrate the Eucharist. This is the Sacrament he instituted for us to remember him. Just as the apostles felt closer to Jesus when they 'broke bread' so do we when we gather at Mass.
