SCHOOL FEES 2018

PARENT INFORMATION SESSIONS

There is no one format that will meet the needs of every family. We have opted for this process rather than have families attend the school on two or three separate nights, depending on the year level of your child/ren. We cannot provide a crèche so we ask that if children need to attend they are under your supervision and not left in the school playground while you are in meetings. I trust that the sessions will provide valuable information for you and your child to help start the year smoothly. Please note that these are general information sessions and if you require further conversations with your child's teacher please make a mutually suitable time to meet on another occasion. It would be great to see as many families as possible attend this night.

I look forward to getting to know many more of our families as we commence the 2018 school year and work in partnership to ensure a quality education and a safe school environment for all.

MATHEMATICS ASSESSMENT INTERVIEW

The students in Year 1 to Year 6 at St Francis will be completing an individual Maths Assessment with their classroom teacher during the first couple of weeks of school. This interview provides us with valuable data on your child's knowledge in counting, place value, addition & subtraction and multiplication & division. We will use the data collected from these assessments to inform us of the best ways to teach your child.

The teachers will be available mornings and afternoons for the next couple of weeks to complete the interviews. Any that they can not completed outside of school hours will be completed during class time. You should have received a note this week for you to book an interview time. Please ensure this slip is returned to your child's teacher. If you are unable to make one of these booking times then the teacher will assess your child during class time.

MEDICATION

If your child requires medication to be administered during the school day, please send it in to the office. An authorisation to administer will need to be completed. Medication can only be given to a child at school if it has been prescribed by a doctor. Please bring all medication clearly marked on the outside with permanent marker.

The School's First Aid department requires updated copies of all Asthma Management Plans, Diabetes Plan and/or Anaphylaxis Action Plans please so that we can be best informed to help them in case of emergency.

WE ARE A NUT FREE SCHOOL

At St Francis there are a number of children who experience anaphylaxis – in particular a severe allergic reaction when they are exposed to peanuts and nut related products. If those children are exposed to these foods a severe allergic reaction can occur and can rapidly become life threatening. Accidental exposure to these foods can happen at eating times and in the case of some students, the allergic reaction can be triggered when another person has touched or eaten these foods and then that person touches them.

As a community we can assist these children by making our school environment safe. We ask families to:

- NOT use peanut, nut and chocolate spreads when making and sending sandwiches to school.
- NEVER send nuts to school for your own child to eat.
- Continually remind children NOT to share their food with other children at school.
- Explain to your children the seriousness of food allergies for those children who are affected by them and that we can help to keep these children safe by the choices we make.

LABELLING OF SCHOOL ITEMS

If items are lost and are put into our lost property box, if they are labelled, they will be returned to the appropriate children.

DOWNLOAD ST FRANCIS SCHOOL'S SKOOLBAG APP STRAIGHT TO YOUR SMARTPHONE OR TABLET DEVICE

For iPhone or iPad users

- 1. Click the "App Store" icon on your Apple device
- 2. Type your school name in the search, using suburb name will help
- 3. If iPhone, you will see you school appear, click "Free" then "Install"
- 4. If iPad, change the drop list to "iPhone Apps", your school will then be visible, click: Free" then: Install"
- 5. When installed click "Open"
- 6. Select "OK" to receive push notifications, when asked
- 7. Click the "More" button on the bottom right of the App, then "Setup"
- 8. Toggle on the Push Categories that are applicable to you

For Android Users:

You must first have signed up with a Google Account before installing the app.

- 1. Click the "Play Store" button on your Android Device
- 2. Click the magnifying glass icon at the top and type in your school name, using the suburb name will help.
- 3. Click the school name when it appears in the search
- 4. Click the "Install" button
- 5. Click "Accept" for various permissions (please note, we do not modify any of your personal data on your device)
- 6. Click the "More" button on the bottom right of the App, then "Setup"
- 7. Toggle on the Push Categories that are applicable to you
