SCHOOL OPAL CARD - DON'T FORGET T TAP ON AND TAP OFF

An important requirement of School Opal is the need for students to Tap On and Tap Off when they travel to and from school.

Opal data gathered by tapping on and off is used to determine demand for bus services.

If children don't Tap on and Tap off, services may be cancelled or reduced due to the lack of recorded patronage. With this in mind, we again ask for your assistance in reminding your children that tapping on and off at the beginning and end of each trip is one of the conditions of using a School Opal card. This in turn helps us ensure we are able to provide the appropriate level of service to your child.

To assist the schools, Busways is developing a campaign to further promote and encourage the use of School Opal. We will also continue to conduct boarding checks on School Opal cards over the coming months. Students without an Opal Card will be given a brochure to take home identifying how they can get an Opal Card.

Please support Busways staff with afternoon boardings and checks to ensure minimal delays to bus departure times and demonstrate a united front to students on bus travel and Opal Card use.

MATHEMATICS ASSESSMENT INTERVIEW

The students in Year 1 to Year 6 at St Francis will be completing an individual Maths Assessment with their classroom teacher during the first couple of weeks of school. This interview provides us with valuable data on your child's knowledge in counting, place value, addition & subtraction and multiplication & division. We will use the data collected from these assessments to inform us of the best ways to teach your child.

The teachers will be available mornings and afternoons for the next couple of weeks to complete the interviews. Any that they can not completed outside of school hours will be completed during class time. You should have received a note this week for you to book an interview time. Please ensure this slip is returned to your child's teacher. If you are unable to make one of these booking times then the teacher will assess your child during class time.
