### STAFF DEVELOPMENT DAY

### On Friday 17th September there will be a Staff Development Day.

This means that there is no school on this day.

The St Francis Staff will undergo professional learning on this day. This staff development day was scheduled for earlier this term, but due to the lockdown was postponed until the last day of Term 3.

COSHC will be providing care on this day for those families that require it. Please notify COSHC as soon as possible if your child will be attending on this day. COSHC on this day will only go ahead if they have enough students attending.

### **RETURN TO SCHOOL TERM 4**

The significant announcements made a couple of weeks by the NSW Government's relating to the "roadmap to freedom", included the announcement that 'stay-at-home' orders for adults who have received both doses of the COVID-19 vaccine will be lifted from the Monday after NSW passes the 70 percent double vaccination target.

The plans for the children to return remain the same i.e., the start of the staggered return of students to face-to-face learning depends upon at least 70 percent of the state's eligible adult population being vaccinated. Current NSW Health projections indicate this will be before mid-October, which is why NSW Health and Education have confidence in the following dates:

- Kindergarten and Year 1 Monday 25<sup>th</sup> October
- Year 2 and Year 6 Monday 1<sup>st</sup> November
- Year 3, Year 4 and Year 5 8<sup>th</sup> November

### NAPLAN YEAR 3 AND 5

Thank you to the families that were able to collect their child's NAPLAN 2021 reports. Parents that were not able to collect the reports by the end of today should receive it next week in the post. NAPLAN assessments are designed to provide parents, students and teachers with information about how the children are progressing in their learning and what supports are needed to continue to improve their level of achievement. Teachers have been given access to the assessment data and have begun looking at the results. If you have any questions once you have received your child's report, please contact the school to discuss.

### HOW READING 20 MINUTES A DAY BENEFITS YOUR CHILD

In our increasingly busy lives it is sometimes tempting to overlook **daily** reading. We sometimes fail to give this reading time the value it deserves. However, in doing so we are significantly short-changing our children and denying them valuable opportunities to learn.

At St Francis we place a great dear of emphasis on reading. Just 20 minutes of reading each day can make an incredible impact over the course of a child's primary school years.

Reading at home can take many forms and should ideally include time for your child to read to you, as well as time when you read to your child.

#### **Reading:**

- Helps in language development
- Promotes brain development
- Aids in understanding of a world outside our own
- Strengthens family relationships
- Provides endless possibilities
- Improves concentration
- Improves listening skills

It is important to have your child read regularly every day rather than in sporadic bursts. Reading as little as 20 minutes per day is far more beneficial than reading 20 books in one day and then reading again for a week. Children must read regularly so as to practise and consolidate their skills. As you can see by the diagram included, reading for 20 minutes each day makes and incredible difference!

### **OUT OF SCHOOL HOURS**

The NSW Department of Education now strongly recommends primary school aged children wear masks in Out of School Hours Care services, including before and after school care services and vacation care. COSHC will now adopt this practice in the interests of strengthening the safety of our services for all in the community. The service seeks the cooperation of families with providing their child with a face mask to wear at COSHC. Practices at COSHC will be adjusted to ensure there are periods when masks can be removed and, at these times, physical distancing will be supported where possible as another measure to limit COVID-19 transmission.

### SYMPTOMS AND TESTING

With the prevalence of COVID-19 in Western Sydney, it is more important than ever students and staff do not attend work or school if unwell, even with mild symptoms of COVID-19.

Any student or staff member with any COVID-19 symptoms will be sent home and should not return until they have received a negative test result and are symptom-free. In circumstances where children have other medical reasons for recurring symptoms, a letter from their GP is sufficient to negate the requirement for a negative test.

Anyone who is unwell with COVID-19 symptoms is to get tested immediately and self-isolate until a negative result is received.


### SUMMER UNIFORM

### **BUILDING UPDATE**







Dear Parents/ Guardians,

Due to Covid-19 there will be no uniform fittings for students starting school in 2022. St Francis Uniform Shop is run online by Oz Fashions. Orders are to be placed on the 'QKR' app by MasterCard.

Please follow all instructions on the attached flyer to download the app and set up your account.

No phone orders or messages will be accepted!

Delivery to the school is every Monday and Wednesday during the school term once school resumes. Orders must be placed by 4:00pm Friday for delivery on Monday and 4:00pm Monday for Wednesday delivery. Please refer to the delivery dates on the QKR app before ordering for any changes.

We have also added a home delivery option and reduced the cost from \$15.00 to \$10.00 for parents who wish to use this option. (We strongly recommend this option as parents are not able to attend the school with the current restrictions).

For any parent who is wishing to pick up their order from Oz Fashions warehouse you must email Elle to organise pick up prior to going to Oz Fashions Granville. Please choose carefully as we do not refund if you simply change your mind or make a wrong selection, however, we gladly exchange within 14 days.

Returned merchandise MUST be in its original condition with all tags still attached and accompanied by proof of purchase otherwise the exchange will not be honoured. Any item that has been worn will not be exchanged.


#### Step 3 Find our school

### Step 4 Register your children


When first accessing our school you will be prompted to add a student profile for your child. This allows you to make orders and payments for them. If you have made a purchase you can select our school from 'Previous Location'
