Parents would have received an email that contains login information for the Compass Parent Portal. If it isn't in your inbox, please check your spam or junk folder. If it is not there give us a call as we may have an old email address.

You will be able to see school news, newsletters and events, view your child's timetable and attendance, provide explanations for you child's absences and update your contact details.

If you have more than one child at the school and they are all absent you will need to do this for each child. If you haven't logged into the parent portal to advise of your child's absence by 9.30am an SMS will be sent to parents prompting you for an explanation.

This is our new form of communication and we will no longer be using Skoolbag. Please ensure you are able to log in to the Compass Parent Portal.
